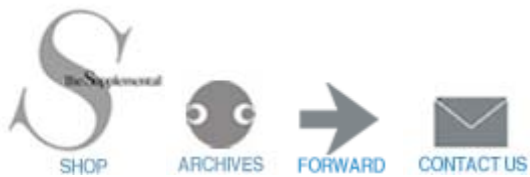
ob-ject les-son; noun [ob-jikt,-jekt les-uhn]

Plunge Pool at Wimpole Hall, 1792. Sir John Soane, (British) Architect (Pool held 2,199 gallons of water heated by a boiler below)

Sir John Soane, 1753-1837) specialized in the Neo-Classical style. He was the official architect to the Office of Works, and received a knighthood in 1831. If you have never visited his home (now a museum) in London, next trip make it your first stop, you won't be sorry..... it's extremely elegant and a bit wacky at the same time.
